Lewis and Clark arrived at the Great Falls of the Missouri, 900 feet wide and 80 feet high, in 1805. To portage around the falls, the Corps had to hike 18 miles, dragging their canoes and supplies. The ground was rocky, uneven, and hard. Prickly pear cactuses were everywhere. They wore through their moccasins every

two days. The intense heat of the summer sun was interrupted by violent storms, with thunder, rain, and hailstones the size of eggs. Swarms of gnats and mosquitoes pestered them. Rattlesnakes and grizzly bears were a constant threat.

Senator George Graham Vest made his mark in history in the trial of a sheep farmer who had killed Old Drum, a hunting dog, for trespassing on his land in 1869. Representing Old Drum's owner, in his impassioned speech to the jury Vest originated the phrase "A man's best friend is his dog". In 1947 a monument to Old Drum was erected on the spot where his body was found, but that marker is apparently lost. In 1958 this statue and the accompanying marker were erected in the courthouse square. Note that the statue is anatomically accurate, and it appears to be a local custom to rub a certain portion of the male dog's anatomy, which is shiny bronze.
