Arlington is a city in Texas, west of Dallas. It's home to the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA), whose campus has a modern planetarium. In River Legacy Parks, trails cut through hardwood forest rich in wildlife. On the other hand... Arlington Iowa is a city in Fayette County, Iowa, United States. The population was 419 in the 2020 census, a decline from the 490 population in the 2000 census. Arlington IA is 38 miles NE of Cedar Falls IA on Hwy 187. Get a photo of the Arlington Community Event Center.

The United States Military Academy, commonly known as West Point, is a United States service academy in West Point, New York, that educates cadets for service as commissioned officers in the United States Army. The academy was founded in 1802, and it is the oldest of the five American service academies. On the other hand... West Point IA is a city in Lee County, Iowa, United States. The population was 921 at the time of the 2020 census. West Point is located 9 miles NW of Fort Madison IA. The library is on Fifth Street just north of Ave D aka Hwy J40 as it goes through town. Montrose is a home rule municipality that is the county seat of and the most populous municipality in Montrose County, Colorado, United States. The city population was 20,291 at the 2020 census. On the other hand... Montrose IA is a city in Lee County, Iowa. The population was 738 at the time of the 2020 census. The town is located on the Mississippi River. The Riverfront Inc Museum is located at 203 N 1st St, just as 1st St is exiting the north end of town. On the side of the museum away from the river are several murals. In Front of the murals are letters spelling "Montrose". Get a phot of the word Montrose.

007 CCM Cincinnati Mural - Cincinnati, IA**Points: 911****40° 37.857' -92° 55.502'**

Cincinnati is a city in Ohio, on the Ohio River. The Over-the-Rhine district is known for its 19th-century architecture, including Findlay Market, which has food and craft vendors. Pop 314,914. On the other hand... Cincinnati IA is a city in Pleasant Township, Appanoose County, Iowa, United States. The population was 290 in the 2020 census. Cincinnati IA is located 8 miles south of Centerville IA on Hwy 5. The mural is on the south side of Hwy 5 as it goes through town. Located 5 miles south of Fairfield IA on Hwy 1. Go east from hwy 1 on East Main Street 3 blocks to the City Park. Look for the flat stone picnic shelter, on the north end is the name Birmingham in large letters. Get a phot of "Birmingham".

009 RBG Rome Bar and Grill - Rome, IA**Points: 471****40° 58.815' -91° 40.958'**

Rome is the capital city and most populated city of Italy. The home of many ancient landmarks such as the Parthenon. On the other hand... Rome IA is a village in Henry County, Iowa, United States. The population was 114 at the time of the 2020 census. Rome is located 7 miles west of Mt Pleasant IA just north of US 34. The Rome Bar and Grill is sadly now closed, I'm sure it was a hopping place in its day. Go north on Clayton Ave. to Broadway Street head east to the bar and grill. Salem is a city on the north coast of Massachusetts above Boston. It's famous for its 1692 witch trials, during which several locals were executed for allegedly practicing witchcraft. Landmarks from this episode include the Witch House, the former home of a trial judge whose last name was Corwin, yes my ancestor. On the other hand... Salem IA is a city in Henry County, Iowa, United States. The population was 394 at the time of the 2020 census. No witches here. Salem IA is 9 miles south of Mt Pleasant IA at the intersection of W55 and J20. The library is on E Cherry 1/2 block off Main Street. 011 WAP Washington Airport - Washington, IA**Points: 364****41° 16.783' -91° 40.132'**

Washington, DC, the U.S. capital, is a compact city on the Potomac River, bordering the states of Maryland and Virginia. It's defined by imposing neoclassical monuments and buildings – including the iconic ones that house the federal government's 3 branches. On the other hand... Washington IA is a city in and the county seat of Washington County, Iowa, United States. It is part of the Iowa City metropolitan area. The population was 7,352 at the time of the 2020 census. Washington IA is 26 miles south of Iowa City on Hwy 1. Heading east on Washington Street aka Hwy 92 near the edge of town go south on Airport Road for 1.3 miles to 260th street. 012 EPL Ely Public Library - Ely, IA**Points: 194****41° 52.401' -91° 35.149'**

Ely is the only city in and the county seat of White Pine County, Nevada, United States. Ely was founded as a stagecoach station along the Pony Express and Central Overland Route. It's also home base for several barely legal LD rides put on by the Conestoga group. On the other hand... Ely IA is a city in Linn County, Iowa. The population was 2,328 at the time of the 2020 census. Ely is about 8 miles SE of Cedar Rapids IA on Hwy E70 aka Ely Road. Once in Ely go east on Dows Street 2 1/2 block to the library. Get a photo of the entrance to the "Ely Public Library".

013 WPO Warsaw Post Office - Warsaw, IA**Points: 79****44° 14.911' -93° 23.609'**

Warsaw, officially the Capital City of Warsaw, is the capital and largest city of Poland. The metropolis stands on the River Vistula in east-central Poland. On the other hand... Warsaw is an unincorporated community and census-designated place in Warsaw Township, Rice County, Minnesota, United States. As of the 2020 census, Warsaw had a population of 644. Warsaw MN is about 5 miles SW of Faribault MN on MN 60. From MN 60 go north on Farwell Ave then east on 234th street. The post office is 1/2 block, it's small. Get a photo of the "Warsaw Post Office".

014 GBG Geneva Bar and Grill - Geneva, MN**Points: 82****43° 49.407' -93° 16.139'**

Geneva is a city in Switzerland that lies at the southern tip of expansive Lac Léman (Lake Geneva). Surrounded by the Alps and Jura mountains, the city has views of dramatic Mont Blanc. Headquarters of Europe's United Nations and the Red Cross, it's a global hub for diplomacy and banking. On the other hand... Geneva MN is a city in Freeborn County, Minnesota, United States. As of the 2020 census, Geneva had a population of 508. Geneva is 13 miles NNE of Albert Lea MN. 016 HCO Holland City Offices - Holland ,IA**Points: 145****42° 23.969' -92° 48.006'**

Holland aka the Netherlands, a country in northwestern Europe, is known for a flat landscape of canals, tulip fields, windmills and cycling routes. Also the home of Noraly Schoenmaker aka Itchy Boots motorcycle world traveler on YouTube. On the other hand... Holland is a city in Grundy County, Iowa, United States. The population was 269 at the time of the 2020 census. Holland is 25 mile WSW of Waterloo IA. From US20 exit 208 go south on hwy 14 4 and 1/2 miles to 210th street, go west 2 miles to Holland. Go north on Main Street to the city offices on the east side of the street. Get a photo of the "Holland City Office" with your motorcycle.

017 WCA Waterloo Center for the Arts - Waterloo, IA**Points: 151****42° 29.871' -92° 20.532'**

Waterloo is a town south of Brussels, in Belgium. It's known as the site of the final defeat of Emperor Napoleon I, in 1815. This final defeat ended the Napoleonic Wars and 23 years of European conflict. It is also famously known as a metaphor for a final, catastrophic defeat. On the other hand... Waterloo IA is a city in and the county seat of Black Hawk County, Iowa, United States. It is the eighth-most populous city in Iowa, with a population of 67,314 at the 2020 census. Waterloo comprises a twin conurbation with neighboring municipality Cedar Falls, and is the larger of the two cities. Waterloo IA is 50 miles NW of Cedar Falls IA. The population was 987 at the time of the 2020 census. Fredericksburg is 34 miles north of Waterloo IA on US18. Off of US18 in Fredericksburg go north on N Hamilton Ave to the city park entrance. New Haven is a coastal city on Long Island Sound, in Connecticut. It's home to the Ivy League Yale University, founded in 1701. The institution's museums include the Yale Peabody Museum of Natural History, the Yale University Art Gallery and the Yale Center for British Art. On the other hand... New Haven is an unincorporated community and census-designated place in Mitchell County, Iowa, United States. As of the 2020 census the population of New Haven was 77. Across the Thames River, the London Eye observation wheel provides panoramic views of the South Bank cultural complex, and the entire city. On the other hand... London MN is an unincorporated community in London Township, Freeborn County, Minnesota, United States. The London Cemetery is about 8 miles SSW for Austin MN. 022 MTH Moscow Town Hall - Moscow, MN**Points: 85****43° 42.532' -93° 05.959'**

Moscow, on the Moskva River in western Russia, is the nation's cosmopolitan capital. In its historic core is the Kremlin, a complex that's home to the president and tsarist treasures in the Armoury. Outside its walls is Red Square, Russia's symbolic center. It's home to Lenin's Mausoleum, the State Historical Museum's comprehensive collection and St. Basil's Cathedral, known for its colorful, onion-shaped domes. On the other hand... Moscow is an unincorporated community in Freeborn County, Minnesota, United States. But they do have a nice Town Hall. Moscow MN is 6 miles NW of Austin MN on hwy 885. From us 218 in Austin take Hwy 27 west which turns in to Hwy 25 aka 240th Street. Go north at the T intersection on Hwy 34. The Moscow Town Hall is on the west side of the road. Get a photo of the "Moscow 4 H" sign With your motorcycle.

023 NVM Nevada Mural - Nevada, IA**Points: 192****42° 01.274' -93° 27.138'**

Nevada sometimes called the Silver State, is a landlocked state in the Western United States. It is also sometimes placed in the Mountain West and Southwestern United States. It borders Oregon to the northwest, Idaho to the northeast, California to the west, Arizona to the southeast, and Utah to the east. On the other hand... Nevada IA is a city in and the county seat of Story County, Iowa, United States. Nevada claims historic markers to both the Jefferson and Lincoln Highways. The population was 6,925 in the 2020 census, an increase from 6,658 in 2000. Nevada IA is located 9 miles east of Ames IA. From I-35 exit 111 go east on US-30 6 miles to Co Rd S14, go north 1 mile to the State Bank and Trust. To the north of the bank is the Mural. Cambridge is a city on the River Cam in eastern England, home to the prestigious University of Cambridge, dating to 1209. University colleges include King's, famed for its choir and towering Gothic chapel, as well as Trinity, founded by Henry VIII, and St John's, with its 16th-century Great Gate. On the other hand... Cambridge, IA is a city in Story County, Iowa, United States. The population was 827 at the 2020 census. It is part of the Ames, Iowa Metropolitan Statistical Area. Cambridge IA has no prestigious universities. Get a photo of the stone "Welcome to Cambridge" sign.

It's renowned for its rich repositories of European art, including the Prado Museum's works by Goya, Velázquez and other Spanish masters. On the other hand... Many of its all-inclusive resorts are clustered in Montego Bay, with its British-colonial architecture, and Negril, known for its diving and snorkeling sites. Jamaica is famed as the birthplace of reggae music, and its capital Kingston is home to the Bob Marley Museum, dedicated to the famous singer. On the other hand... Jamaica IA is a city in Guthrie County, Iowa, United States. The population was 195 at the time of the 2020 census. No reef-lined beaches here. But there is Tojo's. Jamaica IA is 40 miles NW of Des Moines IA on IA-141. From IA-141 and IA-4 go east 3 miles then north on Wood Ave. aka Co Rd P-30 for 0.7 of a mile. Head east on Railway Street to Main Street north to Tojo's. Get a photo of "Tojo's of Jamaica Bar and Grill"

027 GJM Grand Junction Mural - Grand Junction, IA**Points: 185****42° 01.902' -94° 14.266'**

Grand Junction is a city in Colorado's Western Slope region. It's known as the hub of Colorado's wine country. Split into 5 sections, James M. Robb - Colorado River State Park offers river access, lakes, biking trails and wildlife. West of the city, trail-lined Colorado National Monument is a park with red sandstone monoliths and canyons. On the other hand... Grand Junction IA is a city in Greene County, Iowa, United States. The population was 725 at the time of the 2020 census. The historic Main Street is part of the Lincoln Highway. Grand Junction IA is 31 miles west of Ames IA on US-30. From US-30 go south on IA-144, go east on Main Street, go 2 blocks to the mural. Get a photo of the "Grand Junction" mural celebrating 150 years.

028 SMT Stratford Mutual Telephone - Stratford, IA**Points: 183****42° 16.289' -93° 55.528'**

Stratford-upon-Avon, a medieval market town in England's West Midlands, is the 16th-century birthplace of William Shakespeare. Possibly the most famous writer in the English language, Shakespeare is known for his sonnets and plays such as 'Romeo and Juliet' and 'Hamlet'. The Royal Shakespeare Company performs his plays in the Royal Shakespeare Theatre and adjacent Swan Theatre on the banks of the River Avon. On the other hand... Stratford IA is a city in Hamilton and Webster counties in the U.S. state of Iowa. The population was 707 at the time of the 2020 census. I'm pretty sure not much Shakespeare happens here. Stratford IA is 20 miles SE of Fort Dodge IA on IA-175. From IA-175 go north on Co Rd R-21 aka Teneyck Ave to Tennyson Ave, head east to the Stratford Mutual Telephone building. 029 SPL Sheffield Public Library - Sheffield, IA**Points: 127****42° 53.562' -93° 12.917'**

Sheffield is a city in the English county of South Yorkshire. In the city centre, the Millennium Gallery shows metalwork and art from Sheffield and around the world. It adjoins the Winter Garden, a large temperate glasshouse filled with plants. On the other hand... Sheffield, Iowa, is a charming small town in Franklin county. Incorporated in 1876, the city spans approximately 5.6 square miles and is home to a population of 1,130.
